Safety Award of Excellence



The Safety Award of Excellence is presented to any FABRICATOR OR AFFILIATE MEMBER EMPLOYER who has experienced a ZERO (0.00) OSHA Total Recordable Incident Rate for 12 consecutive months.

Safety Award of Achievement



The Safety Award of Achievement is presented to any FABRICATOR OR AFFILIATE MEMBER EMPLOYER who has experienced a minimum 10% reduction in the OSHA Total Recordable Incident Rate during the 2014 calendar year, with no fatalities, as compared with the average Total Recordable Incident Rate for the three previous years.

TFWG companies that received STI's Safety Award of Achievement:

Blastco Texas Inc. - (31.5% reduction in TRIR)

Blastech (Canada) - (54% reduction in TRIR)

BIR (Canada) - (23.6 % reduction in TRIR)

Total TFWarren Group - (28% reduction in TRIR)
